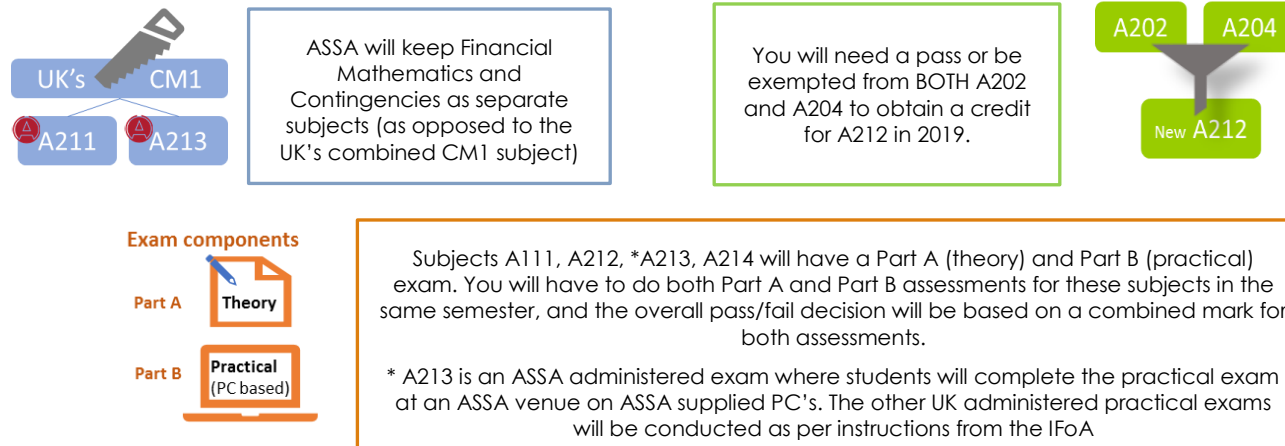


Quick Update

Curriculum 2019 structure is now finalised!

There is no deadline to apply for exemptions. Exemptions granted on the old codes will translate into the new curriculum and codes. We recommend that you apply for exemptions as soon as possible.

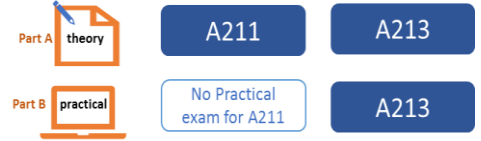
** The **Foundation Actuarial Professional Practice (APP)** commenced in this year with the following exemption criteria:

- Students who join ASSA as a student member before 1 Jan 2018.
- Students who join ASSA as a student member before 1 Jan 2020 and who meet the admission criteria for Core APP.
- Students who meet the university requirements to graduate with an accredited degree from an ASSA level 2 or 3 accredited university before 1 Jan 2021.

2019 Exams – A211 and A213

Since ASSA is keeping A211 – Financial Mathematics and A213 – Contingencies as two separate subjects, there has been a significant amount of discussion to ensure we have an appropriate exam structure for these 2 subjects. The final decision is as follows:

- A211 – Theory exam only
- A213 – Theory exam and a Practical exam



For A213 - Both Part A and B of an exam must be written and passed in the same semester (as with all the exams that have a Part A and Part B)

The A211 and A213 are ASSA administered exams and therefore the A213 Practical exam will be written at an ASSA venue on ASSA supplied PC's. (A111, A212 and A214 Practical Exams are administered by the IFoA)

All the other exam structures are on the ASSA webpage under Curriculum 2019.

Buying A-level Study Notes for 2019

The introduction of the new curriculum has resulted in a re-structure as well as various degrees of updates to all the A-level subjects' study notes. **We therefore recommend that you do purchase NEW NOTES.** ActEd indicated that re-taker discounts will still apply.
