

2026 semester 2 registration dates



Registrations for Semester 2 2026 ASSA-administered examinations and Education Support Initiatives will open on 1 July 2026.

Please note that registration windows will differ across activities, in line with the timelines and delivery requirements for each activity. Please refer to the ASSA Registration Dates S2 for the full list of Semester 2 education activities and their corresponding registration dates.

All Education Support Initiatives will be hosted virtually. ASSA-coordinated examinations will take place both in-venue and virtually. Candidates who wish to write examinations virtually will be required to meet the minimum technical requirements and complete compulsory testing in advance of the examination.

For candidates writing ASSA-administered examinations at an ASSA venue, all first-time writers are required to complete compulsory testing before their examinations. Successful completion of the testing process will be mandatory to ensure examination readiness. Further communication regarding invigilation procedures, examination preparation requirements, and testing processes will be shared in the coming weeks.

To enable successful registration, please note the following **important registration guidance**:

- **Membership Requirements:** Candidates must ensure that their 2026 ASSA membership is active and in good standing prior to registration. Where accounts are outstanding, candidates are encouraged to resolve these well in advance of registration, **as ASSA will not be able to accommodate exceptions or late registrations** due to unsettled accounts. Please note that **members with blocked accounts will not be able to register** for any ASSA activities or events.
- **Activity-Specific Registration Windows:** Each education activity has its own defined registration period. Candidates should ensure they review and adhere to the relevant dates for the activities they intend to undertake. **Late registrations will not be accommodated** once the registration period has closed.

IFoA Examination Registrations:

Registration for examinations outsourced to the Institute and Faculty of Actuaries (IFoA) opened on 22 June 2026 and will close on 12 July 2026.

ASSA members will continue to have the option of sitting IFoA examinations either:

- Virtually via remote proctoring, or
- In-person at a designated examination venue

Venue-based sittings will only proceed where a minimum of 10 candidates per examination, per venue elect to write at that venue. Where this minimum threshold is not met, affected candidates will be transferred to the virtual examination format.

While both delivery options remain available, candidates are encouraged to carefully consider the benefits of writing at a designated examination venue.

ASSA continues to observe that a disproportionate number of examination incidents, technical disruptions and examination sanctions arise in remote examination sittings when compared to venue-based examinations. Although some candidates successfully complete virtual examinations, the remote format inherently introduces a range of risks that are outside the control of ASSA and the IFoA.

How to Register:

N.B: All members are to renew their membership subscriptions before registering for ASSA activities.

- Go to the Society home page at <http://www.actuarialsociety.org.za>
- Click on the member log in link at the top of the page and log into your member profile.
- Before you register for anything: ensure that your profile has been updated with any special requirements you may have e.g., dietary / extra time requirements.
- Click on Registration at the top and select New Registration.
- Select your regional centre from the drop-down list.
- Select the education activity from drop-down menus i.e., Counselling / Exam / Course etc.
- Click on the register button on the right of the subject you wish to register for,
- Check that all details are correct and make sure that you note the additional comments if there are any.
- Read the Terms and Conditions and check the tick box confirming so.
- You will receive an email after a few minutes with the details of the subjects for which you have entered. There will be a separate e-mail for every subject for which you entered.
- De-registration: To de-register within the registration period click on the Registration link at the top and select "Deregistration" - select the relevant drop-down menu and then de-register next to the required subject. Please note that you cannot de-register once the registration period has closed.
