

ASSA Exam Fact of the Day:

Know when you need to be ready to write

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An important reminder for this examination session: make sure you are familiar with the arrival, seating and start-time requirements that apply on examination day.

Writing at a venue?

You must be seated in the examination venue 30 minutes before your scheduled examination start time. Venue doors will close at this point.

For example:

09:00 exam → you must be seated by 08:30.

 If you arrive after the seating cut-off time, you will not be permitted entry and will forfeit your examination attempt.

Once seated, you may not leave the venue until 30 minutes after the examination starts, so please use restroom facilities before presenting yourself for registration. You may also not leave the venue during the final 30 minutes of the examination.

The 30-minute period before the examination allows invigilators to complete essential checks, provide instructions and ensure systems are functioning correctly before the examination begins.

Writing remotely?

You must be logged into the examination system at your scheduled examination start time.

The previous one-hour grace period for late logins has been removed. If you are not logged in at the scheduled start time, you will forfeit your examination attempt.

 **Plan ahead and make sure you are ready on time.**
